## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Agreement made and entered into on this Jan 9<sup>th</sup> day of 2019 between **KARTAVYA- The Career Assister** (hereinafter called K-TCA) situated at 203,Paragon Square, S.N. Ganguly Road, Ranchi- 834001 and **Jharkhand College** (hereinafter called " **Jharkhand College** " which expression shall include its successors and permitted assignees) with its registered office at Ishri, Bazar Giridih.

### 1. OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is:

- a. to promote interaction between K-TCA and COLLEGE in mutually beneficial areas.
- b. to provide a formal basis for initiating interaction between K-TCA and COLLEGE.

### 2. PROPOSED MODES OF COLLABORATION

K-TCA and COLLEGE propose to collaborate through

- a) Providing student "PROFESSIONAL RECRUITMENT TRAINING" program in 5th & 6th semester and assisting college in placement activities like Campus Recruitment Drive at COLLEGE Campus, Event Organizing and Managing ( In respective to placement only ) and Placement Lessening as well.
- b) The eligibility criteria for student selection in campus recruitment will be as per norms of COMPANIES.
- c) Handling placement data of COLLEGE and providing as per COLLEGE need.
- d) training of COLLEGE students through Continuing Educational Programs conducted by K-TCA in Professional Recruitment Training to COLLEGE .
- e) any other appropriate mode of interaction agreed upon between K-TCA and COLLEGE.

Each of the above modes of interaction will be initiated by entering into a separate agreement between the two parties.

### 1. CONFIDENTIALITY

- a. During and for a period of three years from the date of disclosure, each party agrees to consider as confidential all information disclosed by the other party in written or tangible form or, if orally disclosed confirmed in writing within thirty days of disclosure and identified as confidential by the disclosing party.
- b. The obligations above shall not extend to any confidential information for which the receiving party can prove that this information:
  - is in the public domain at the time of disclosure or comes within the public domain without fault of the receiving party.
  - is already known or become known to the receiving party
  - is received from a third party having no obligations of confidentiality to the disclosing party,
  - is independently developed by the receiving party; or
  - is required to be disclosed by law or court order.

### 2. NON-EXCLUSIVITY

The relationship of the parties under this MOU shall be nonexclusive and both parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries and divisions, are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind.

### 3. TERMS AND TERMINATION

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written agreement of the parties, shall expire 3 years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. This MOU may be amended or terminated earlier by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other party. However, no such early termination of this MOU, whether mutual or unilateral, shall affect the obligations of the participants under any other agreement entered into pursuant to this MOU, which obligations shall survive any such termination.

### 4. RELATIONSHIP

Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to make either party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.

### 5. ASSIGNMENT

It is understood by the Parties herein this MOU is based on the professional competence and expertise of each party and hence neither Party shall transfer or assign this Agreement, or rights or obligations arising hereunder, either wholly or in part, to any third party.

### 6. COSTS OF THE MOU

Both Parties shall not be bearer any type of respective costs of carrying out the obligations under this MOU.

### 7. SIGNED IN DUPLICATE

This MOU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version of the Agreement and having equal legal validity.

## Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Jharkhand College, Dumri & Parasnath Mahavidyalay, Isri Bazar

### Introduction:

**PARTY 1** and **COMPANY** shall hereinafter be referred to as such or collectively as "**Parties**" and individually as "**Party**".



**WHEREAS** both the Parties herein wish to pursue discussions and negotiate with each other for the purpose of entering into a potential business arrangement in relation to the IMS.

**AND WHEREAS**, each Party wishes to review such Confidential Information of the other for the sole purpose of determining their mutual interest in engaging in the Proposed project;

**IN CONNECTION WITH THE ABOVE, THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **"Confidential and or proprietary Information"** shall mean and include any information disclosed by one Party (Disclosing Party) to the other (Receiving Party) either directly or indirectly, in writing, orally, by inspection of tangible objects (including, without limitation, documents, prototypes, samples, media, documentation, discs and code). Confidential information shall include, without limitation, any materials, trade secrets, network information, configurations, trademarks, brand name, know-how, business and marketing plans, financial and operational information, and all other non-public information, material or data relating to the current and/ or future business and operations of the Disclosing Party and analysis, compilations, studies, summaries, extracts or other documentation prepared by the Disclosing Party. Confidential Information may also include information disclosed to the Receiving Party by third parties on behalf of the Disclosing Party.
2. The Receiving Party shall refrain from disclosing, reproducing, summarising and/or distributing Confidential Information and confidential materials of the Disclosing Party except in connection with the Proposed project.
3. The Parties shall protect the confidentiality of each other's Confidential Information in the same manner as they protect the confidentiality of their own proprietary and confidential information of similar nature. Each Party, while acknowledging the confidential and proprietary nature of the Confidential Information agrees to take all reasonable measures at its own expense to restrain its representatives from prohibited or unauthorised disclosure or use of the Confidential Information.
4. Confidential Information shall at all times remain the property of the Disclosing Party and may not be copied or reproduced by the Receiving Party without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent.
5. Within seven (7) days of a written request by the Disclosing Party, the Receiving Party shall return/destroy (as may be requested in writing by the Disclosing Party or upon expiry and or earlier termination) all originals, copies, reproductions and summaries of Confidential Information provided to the Receiving Party as Confidential Information. The Receiving Party shall certify to the Disclosing Party in writing that it has satisfied its obligations under this paragraph.
6. The Receiving Party may disclose the Confidential Information only to the Receiving Party's employees and consultants on a need-to-know basis. The Receiving Party shall have executed or

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shall execute appropriate written agreements with third parties, in a form and manner sufficient to enable the Receiving Party to enforce all the provisions of this Agreement.

7. Confidential Information, however, shall not include any information which the Receiving Party can show:
  - a. is in or comes into the public domain otherwise than through a breach of this Agreement or the fault of the Receiving Party; or
  - b. was already in its possession free of any such restriction prior to receipt from the Disclosing Party; or
  - c. was independently developed by the Receiving Party without making use of the Confidential Information; or
  - d. has been approved for release or use (in either case without restriction) by written authorisation of the Disclosing Party.
8. In the event either Party receives a summon or other validly issued administrative or judicial process requiring the disclosure of Confidential Information of the other Party, the Receiving Party shall promptly notify the Disclosing Party. The Receiving Party may disclose Confidential Information to the extent such disclosure is required by law, rule, regulation or legal process; *provided however*, that, to the extent practicable, the Receiving Party shall give prompt written notice of any such request for such information to the Disclosing Party, and agrees to co-operate with the Disclosing Party, at the Disclosing Party's expense, to the extent permissible and practicable, to challenge the request or limit the scope thereof, as the Disclosing Party may reasonably deem appropriate.
9. Neither Party shall use the other's name, trademarks, proprietary words or symbols or disclose under this Agreement in any publication, press release, marketing material, or otherwise without the prior written approval of the other. On account of signing of this agreement by the representatives of both parties shall mean that one may use the name of the client for marketing purposes physically or digitally.
10. Each Party agrees that the conditions in this Agreement and the Confidential Information disclosed pursuant to this Agreement are of a special, unique, and extraordinary character and that an impending or existing violation of any provision of this Agreement would cause the other Party irreparable injury for which it would have no adequate remedy at law and further agrees that the other Party shall be entitled to obtain immediately injunctive relief prohibiting such violation, in addition to any other rights and remedies available to it at law or in equity.
11. The Receiving Party shall indemnify the Disclosing Party for all costs, expenses or damages that Disclosing Party incurs as a result of any violation of any provisions of this Agreement. This obligation shall include court, litigation expenses, and actual, reasonable attorney's fees. The Parties acknowledge that as damages may not be a sufficient remedy for any breach under this Agreement,

the non-breaching party is entitled to seek specific performance or injunctive relief (as appropriate) as a remedy for any breach or threatened breach, in addition to any other remedies at law or in equity.

12. Neither Party shall be liable for any special, consequential, incidental or exemplary damages or loss (or any lost profits, savings or business opportunity) regardless of whether a Party was advised of the possibility of the damage or loss asserted.
13. Both the Parties agree that by virtue of the Parties entering into this Agreement neither Party is obligated to disclose all or any of the Confidential Information to the other as stated in this Agreement. The Parties reserve the right to disclose only such information at its discretion and which it thinks, is necessary to disclose in relation to the Proposed project.
14. Both the Parties agree that this Agreement will be effective from the date of execution of this Agreement by both Parties and shall continue to be effective till the Proposed project is terminated by either Party by giving a thirty (30) days notice, in case either Party foresees that the Proposed project would not be achieved.

Not with standing anything contained herein, the provisions of this Agreement shall survive and continue after expiration or termination of this Agreement for a further period of five year(s) from the date of expiration.

It being further clarified that notwithstanding anything contained herein, in case a binding agreement is executed between the Parties in furtherance of the Proposed project, the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall become effective and form a part of that binding agreement and be co-terminus with such binding agreement and shall be in effect till the term of such binding agreement and shall after its expiry and or early termination shall continue to be in force in the following manner:

- a. 2 years after the termination of the binding agreement
  - b. 2 years after the expiry of the binding agreement
- (whichever is earlier)

15. Each Party warrants that it has the authority to enter into this Agreement.
16. If any provision of this agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable to any extent, the remainder of this Agreement shall not be affected and each provision hereof shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law. Any invalid or unenforceable provision of this Agreement shall be replaced with a provision that is valid and enforceable and most nearly reflects the original intent of the unenforceable provision.
17. This Agreement may be executed in two counterparts, each of which will be deemed to be an original, and all of which, when taken together, shall be deemed to constitute one and the same agreement.

The place of arbitration shall be Bangalore, India and the arbitration proceedings shall take place in the English language.
20. Additional oral agreements do not exist. All modifications and amendments to this Agreement must be made in writing.
21. The Agreement and/or any rights arising from it cannot be assigned or otherwise transferred either wholly or in part, without the written consent of the other Party.
22. The validity of the agreement between both the parties stands to be as specified in the quotation. Post which, the agreement has to be renewed. The company reserves the right to bring about any change in the company general or technical policies with discussion among the board members. Such policies may be enforced with prior intimation to the college authorities.
